

The City of Ecorse Fire Department is accepting applications for part time reserve Fire Fighter positions. The applicant must have good interpersonal-public relation skills and be able to work a variety of shifts including holidays and weekends.

The applicant must also meet the following minimum qualifications:

- Be a Michigan Resident.

- Possess a valid Michigan driver's license.

- Must have successfully passed training and certification of Fire Fighter I and II.

- Must have completed training and certification at the level of Medical First Responder or higher level of medical training.

- Must be able to successfully pass a comprehensive background investigation, medical examination, drug screen and credit history checks.

Duties include responding to emergency situations of accidental, medical, and industrial nature and taking appropriate action as needed to handle fires, medical emergencies and other fire department related emergencies. Additional responsibilities include writing reports involving fire and medical incidents, continuous training in fire department related disciplines and performing fire department functions as directed.

The rate of pay for a part-time reserve Fire Fighter is \$12.00 per hour with a maximum of 24 hours per week. Part-time positions do not include benefits. The City of Ecorse will provide uniforms and the equipment necessary to perform the functions of a Fire Fighter.
