

The City of Ecorse Police Department is accepting applications for part time police officer positions. The applicant must have good interpersonal-public relation skills and be able to work a variety of shifts including holidays and weekends.

The applicant must also meet the following minimum qualifications:

- Be a Michigan Resident.

- Possess a valid Michigan driver's license.

- Have obtained valid MCOLES certification or certifiable.

- Possess a two year degree in criminal justice or related field or equivalent combination of education and experience.

- Must be able to successfully pass a comprehensive background investigation, medical examination, drug screen and credit history checks.

Duties include patrolling the City of Ecorse and enforcing local and state laws and parking regulations; providing service functions including directing traffic and assistance to citizens; responding to emergency situations of accidental, medical, industrial and criminal nature and taking appropriate action as needed. Additional responsibilities include investigating criminal and non-criminal incident complaints received from the community, writing reports involving incidents for presentation to the Prosecuting Attorney's Office; working with citizens on crime prevention issues and other related tasks and provide other non-criminal complaint services as directed.

The rate of pay for a part-time police officer is \$16.45 per hour with a maximum of 24 hours per week. Part-time positions do not include benefits. The City of Ecorse will provide uniforms and the equipment necessary to perform the functions of a police officer.
